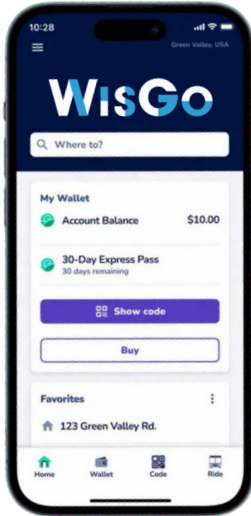

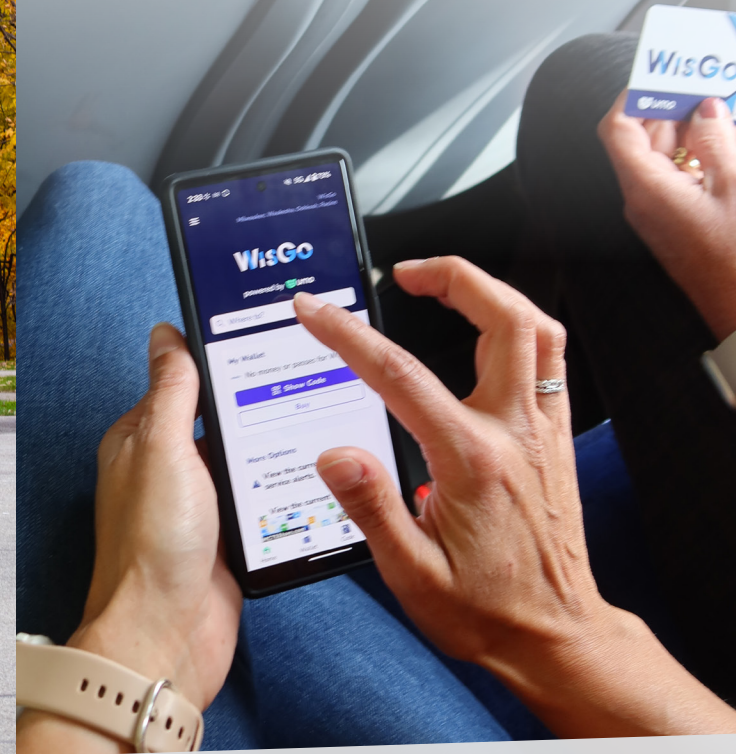

Get Started with WisGo Today

Download the Umo Mobility App from the App Store or Google Play



- Choose "WisGo" for your location.
- Click "Sign in" to create a new account **using an email address.**
- Click "buy" to add money to your Wallet using Apple Pay, Google Pay, credit or debit card.

OR

Get a WisGo Card



- WisGo cards are available in Appleton at our Downtown Transit Center and the Valley Transit office located at 801 S. Whitman Avenue.
- Load money on your card at **UmoPass.com** or at a local retailer.

Reduced Fare Riders

- To qualify for the reduced or youth fare, eligible riders must complete Valley Transit's Reduced Fare Application to become certified.
- The reduced fare application can be found at **myvalleytransit.com/reduced-fare.** Contact Valley Transit at (920) 832-5800 for more information.
- Reduced fare riders can choose to use the Umo Mobility app **OR** a WisGo card.
- Without certification, the adult fare will apply.

Understanding Fare Capping

Ride More. Save More.

Instead of purchasing daily or monthly passes, the WisGo system deducts fare value from your account for each trip. When you tap your card or scan your app onboard the bus, the WisGo system deducts the fare from your account. For each ride payment, a free 90-minute transfer period is provided to get you where you need to go. For further rides, WisGo stops charging once you've reached the daily or monthly cap. Once a cap is reached, all rides and transfers are free.

1. Pick Your Payment Type

Fare capping only works if you use the same payment option for all rides. Choose the app or card.

2. Tap Your Card or Scan the App to Pay

Each bus has an onboard validator. When you board, just tap your card or scan your app. The system will deduct a fare for your first trip and then provide a free 90-minute transfer period.

3. Enjoy Free Rides

Once you've hit the daily or monthly max all rides are free for the rest of the time period.



I purchased my fare on the Umo Mobility app. Now what?

Paying for your ride with the Umo Mobility app uses a QR code linked to your Umo account once you purchase your fare. Simply scan the QR code at the validator.

How will I know if my fare is accepted by the validator?

You will hear a happy chime and see a green light if your fare is accepted. You will hear a buzz and see a red light if your fare is not accepted.

How will I know if I am low on funds in my card or app account?

The onboard validator will provide a balance each time you ride. The app home screen will provide your balance at all times. If you register your card at UmoPass.com, you can view your balance anytime online.

What if I want to pay with cash?

Exact cash fare will continue to be an option for single rides. However, fare capping and transfers do not work with cash.

Adult Fare For riders ages 19-64

You'll Never Pay More Than:

\$4 Daily | \$60 Monthly*

\$2.00 PER RIDE

Reduced Fare

For riders 65+, VT II Certified, Medicare Card or with a qualifying disability

You'll Never Pay More Than:

\$2 Daily | \$40 Monthly*

\$1.00 PER RIDE

Youth Fare For riders ages 5-18

(Children 4 and under ride for free with a paying rider)

You'll Never Pay More Than:

\$1.50 Daily | \$22 Monthly*

\$0.75 PER RIDE

*Monthly cap applies from the first day of the calendar month through the last day of the same month.
