EFFECTIVE REGIONAL COORDINATION


Valley Transit partners with 9 municipalities, 3 counties and many other entities to provide diverse transportation services across the Fox Cities area. Our partners include:

SERVICES

Fixed-Route Bus

- 18 fixed routes serving the Fox Cities
- 3 limited service routes serving the Appleton Area School District
- 1 summer trolley route serving Downtown Appleton
- Direct connections to intercity bus services in downtown Appleton

ADA Paratransit

Accessible vans providing demand response rides to persons with disabilities.

Connector

Unique demand response service providing rides to community members outside of bus service area or after bus service hours. Trips are primarily work related.
